So, how do you prepare for a new sector? And how can you position yourself to succeed?

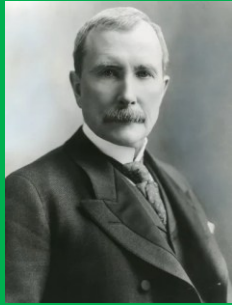
